

### **231 Yacht Club Dr Inspector's Timeline:**

- **10/24/2024** — Permit application for the generator was submitted, but no approval was issued before installation.
- **4/23/2025** — First notice sent requiring removal of the generator.
- **6/5/2025** — Final notice to remove the generator was issued.
- **1/6/2026** — Citation was issued for the violation.
- **2/6/2026** — Sound inspection/test was conducted, showing a reading of **68 dB**.

A few points that may matter depending on your situation:

- The installation appears to have occurred **before permit approval**, which is usually the central code issue.
- The municipality gave multiple notices before issuing the citation, which may be used to show continued noncompliance.
- The **68 dB** reading could matter if there is a local noise ordinance or generator sound limit. Whether 68 dB is compliant depends on:
  - the local code,
  - distance from property lines,
  - time of day,
  - and how the ordinance measures sound.
