- 4. The heating, ventilation, air conditioning system, materials, and installation methods shall comply with OBC Mechanical Code, ASHRAE Standards, SACNA Standards, Equipment Underwriters Approval, the manufacturer's recommendations and specifications and good engineering practices.

- 5. The Electrical system shall comply with the requirements of OBC, and the National Electrical Code (NEC) NFPA 70, OBC approved edition.
- 6. The above examination does not relieve the architect or general contractor from full compliance with the city ordinances and codes. Plans to be reviewed by the Fire Dept. for fire prevention.
