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## 1. Heather Anderson

20821 Avalon Dr.

Two-story rear addition with covered patio

Present – Heather Anderson, Homeowner Mark Ramirez, Architectural Designer Jason Amato, General Manager

- Refreshing the exterior of the home
- Rebuilding the existing garage
- Tearing down the existing addition and rebuilding it a little bit bigger
- Full interior renovation
- Adding a covered patio in the rear
- The front of the house will get its brick painted, new siding, and new windows; the bones will remain the same
- Reroofing the whole house
- Siding will be Hardie Cedarmill Lap Siding
- The Pella Windows will be white to match other accent colors
- The roof over the patio and the bump out on the existing home will be metal
- Some windows will be removed that were in odd places, like the attic and closet
- The shutters should be removed and instead just use the same trim that goes around the other windows

## 2. Peter Quinlan & Rebecca Roemer

**Bathroom Addition** 

1740 Wright Ave.

Present – Peter Quinlan, Homeowner Rebecca Roemer, Homeowner

- Dormer the roof on the backside of the house to create a third-floor master suite
- Will do a Hardie Board Siding, not sure what color yet
- The existing side porch will be refurbished, removing the rotten wood and adding Hardie Board Siding
- The siding for the bathroom and the porch will be consistent

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- The windows for the porch will be new
- A metal roof will be on the bathroom addition
- The siding will be flush with the brick, might want some trim
- The drawings might be lacking in terms of what is needed for the Building Department
- Dormers should not be the same width as the building below, it should be set back on both sides
- It is okay to build on the third floor of a home just not the whole floor and it should not look like a three-story tower
- Changing the siding to a darker color but keeping the trim white around the vinyl windows
- Mr. Jennings would like it to come back to see it with an approved plan from the building department
- Some existing photos from the rear of the house
- Wants to hear more about colors

## 3. Michael Bertin

Half bath and mudroom addition

246 Cornwall Rd.

- Demolish an existing back deck and 2<sup>nd</sup> story patio
- Replacing it with a single-story ½ bath and mudroom
- The materials will match the existing home
- Will replace the existing windows in the rear
- The Board thinks it's a pretty simple addition and view mudrooms

## 4. Gather Food + Drink

Awning over patio

20253 Lake Rd.

Present – Matt Barnes, Owner Julie Barnes, Owner

- There are no awnings on the neighboring businesses
  - Put an awning over the existing patio
- The restaurant is an intimate space, with the patio it's nice to have an awning over it so when it rains, they don't have to kick anyone out
- The awning would be the color of the existing siding
- The awning material is vinyl fabric

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- Everything underneath and the poles are black metal
- The awning can be power washed and/or removed when it needs to be cleaned
- The awning will start just a little bit above the windows, right at the trim pieces
- Not super crazy about the material, hopes it's not shiny and more of a matte
- The owners said that it is not shiny, and it has a matte finish
- Prefer to have the color of the awning match the trim but they couldn't find one that matched
- 34' x 11' covered space which gives about 5-6 tables

Mr. Evans motioned to approve as submitted with the stipulation that the material be a flat finished fabric rather than a shiny one. Mr. Jennings seconded.
