

ORDINANCE NO. 53-26

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING, COMPANY, INC., FOR THE BEACHCLIFF AND CORNWALL SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$6,673,393.50, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT “A.”

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Beachcliff and Cornwall Sewer Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received on May 29, 2026, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer along with the Director of Public Safety-Service have evaluated the bids and recommend the bid from Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Company, Inc., in an amount not to exceed Six Million Six Hundred Seventy Three Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Three Dollars and 50/100 (\$6,673,393.50), as further described in the attached Exhibit “A.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc., 20389 First Avenue, Middleburg Hts., OH, 44130, for the Beachcliff and Cornwall Sewer Improvement Project in an amount not to exceed Six Million Six Hundred Seventy Three Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Three Dollars and 50/100 (\$6,673,393.50), as further described in the attached Exhibit “A.”

SECTION 2. That the cost of the Beachcliff and Cornwall Sewer Improvement Project shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation and Capital Improvement Funds.

SECTION 3. Funding for the project in an estimated amount of One Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars and 0/100 (\$197,750.00) has been awarded to the City of Rocky River by the City of Cleveland’s Division of Water as part of the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program and the City has been awarded a loan not-to-exceed Two Million Two Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars and 0/100 (\$2,223,300.00) from the Ohio Public Works Commission with an amortization period of thirty (30) years to commence upon completion of the project.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

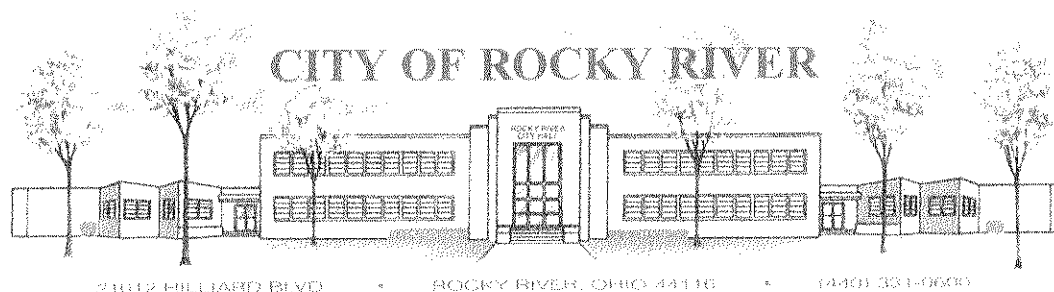

Christian Maier with the City of Shaker Heights, and Nick Fini with the City of Beachwood provided favorable recommendations.
