ORDINANCE NO. 48-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 2018 SEWER JET / VACUUM TRUCK FOR THE SERVICE DIVISION FROM BEST EQUIPMENT CO., INC. AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$298,760.00 2nd READING

Councilman O'Donnell said that this ordinance was discussed last week and it was necessary to have this Special Meeting this evening so that this ordinance will have three full reads. This ordinance is to approve the purchase of a Sewer Jet / Vacuum Truck for the Service Division from Best Equipment Co., Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$298,760.00. The city is currently renting a vehicle for this purpose for \$12,000 a month. Mr. O'Donnell anticipates a third read next week.

President Moran inquired if this particular vehicle is a 2018 demo vehicle.
 Director Costello will verify the year of the vehicle with Best Equipment Co., and will report back next week.

ORDINANCE NO. 49-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER AND AECOM FOR PROFESSIONAL SANITARY ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE ROCKY RIVER WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE

HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$197,324.00) 1st READING

The contract will be split between the four cities for Capital Improvement. Four bids were received and AECOM was the most qualified of the group.
