RESOLUTION NO. 17-22

BY: JOHN B. SHEPHERD A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ODOT ROAD SALT CONTRACTS TO BE AWARDED IN 2022 (2ND READ)

Mr. Shepherd stated the City participates in the salt program with the State in order to get the advantage of the superior buying power. This year the City will place an order for 2200 tons that will bring our total in storage for next season to 4000 tons. Mr. Shepherd would like to see this passed prior to the deadline, so he would like it to be for passage on April 11.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-22 BY: JOHN B. SHEPHERD

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TEAMSTERS LOCAL UNION 436 REPRESENTING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE ROCKY RIVER SERVICE DIVISION, AND CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" (2ND READ)

Mr. Shepherd stated under State of Ohio law once an agreement is reached in a collective bargaining situation, it has to be acted upon within 30 days or it is accepted. We prefer to act within those 30 days, so for this ordinance a passage date of April 11, 2022 is anticipated. This agreement followed the wage pattern set by the other bargaining units.
