ORDINANCE NO. 34-23
BY: THOMAS J. HUNT AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RMH CONCRETE & FOUNDATIONS, FOR THE SAFETY TOWN PROJECT AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$269,610.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" 3<sup>rd</sup> READ

Mr. Hunt said this ordinance has been pending for a few weeks. Mr. Hunt has not had any specific questions or follow up. Ordinance No. 34-23 will authorize the city to enter into a contract with RMH Concrete & Foundations for the long-awaited Safety Town Project. The cost will not exceed \$269,610. The bid from RMH was the only bid received and was 3.2% over the engineer's estimate. Since it is the only bidder and is within the 10%, the city can move forward. There has been no further discussion about that issue. RMH has performed work within the city including the 2022 Streets Program, the concrete curbs for Elle's Enchanted Forest Playground and have been recommended for the Beachcliff TLCI Project. They have received favorable recommendations from the City of Mayfield Heights and the City of Mentor. RMH is an ODOT prequalified contractor and has satisfactorily performed several other ODOT projects and there were no unresolved findings on the State Auditor Database. The Safety Town Project will be a year-round attraction for the community. Mr. Hunt moved for passage Ordinance No. 34-23, seconded by Mr. Sindelar.
