ORDINANCE NO. 3-16

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MI-TECH SERVICES, INC. FOR STORM AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM SERVICES FOR 2016 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$61,494.95

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for storm & sanitary system services, including televising and cleaning for (1) year period with an option to renew for an additional one year for the City of Rocky River; and

WHEREAS, five (5) bids were received on January 5, 2015 and after review by the Director of Public Safety Service, she deems it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to accept the lowest and best bid for storm & sanitary system services from Mi-Tech Services., copies of bids are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement Works to perform storm & sanitary sewer cleaning, televising, etc. services with Mi-Tech Services, Inc., 46 S Rolling Meadows Dr., Fon du Lac, WI 54937 and this one (1) year contract includes an option for renewal on an annual basis in an amount not to exceed Sixty One Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Four Dollars and 95/100 (\$61,494.95).

SECTION 2. That the storm and sanitary sewer cleaning and televising services, and other sewer work as necessary, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund – Televising account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason these services are necessary due to the emergency nature of investigation of sewer failures and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
