AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 30-16

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING & PAVING CO., INC. FOR THE TONAWANDA DRIVE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$129,237.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Tonawanda Drive Water Main Replacement Project; and,

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc., be accepted which is not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars and 00/100 (\$129,237.00) as further explained in Exhibit "B".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc., 389 Columbia Rd., Valley City, Ohio 44280-9799 for the Tonawanda Drive Water Main Replacement Project.

SECTION 2. That \$129,237.00 shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Contractors account.

SECTION 3. That the City will be reimbursed by Cleveland Water Division through the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program as further described in Exhibit "B".

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately because of imperative nature of the maintenance of the water utility and that by immediately commencing work will allow the City to fully use the construction season ahead and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

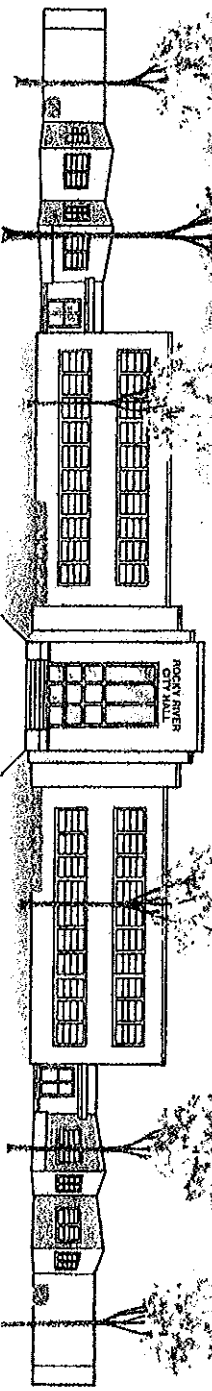
