AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 36-16

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH UTILICON
CORPORATION FOR THE LAKEVIEW AVENUE AND HAMPTON ROAD WATER
MAIN CLEANING & LINING PROJECT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$400,362.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Lakeview Avenue and Hampton Road Water Main Cleaning & Lining Project; and,

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A"; which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Utilicon Corporation be accepted which is not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and 00/100 (\$400,362.00); and

WHEREAS, a section of water line compromised of Hampton Road involves cleaning and lining for which the City of Cleveland authorizes the City of Rocky River to restore at the City's cost as described in Exhibit "B".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Utilicon Corporation, 888 East 70th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44103 for the Lakeview Avenue and Hampton Road Water Main Cleaning & Lining Project.

SECTION 2. That \$400,362.00 shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Contractors Account.

SECTION 3. That the City will be reimbursed by Cleveland Water Division through the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program for Lakeview Avenue as further described in Exhibit "B".

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately because of imperative nature of the maintenance of the water utility and that by immediately commencing work will allow the City to fully use the construction season ahead and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

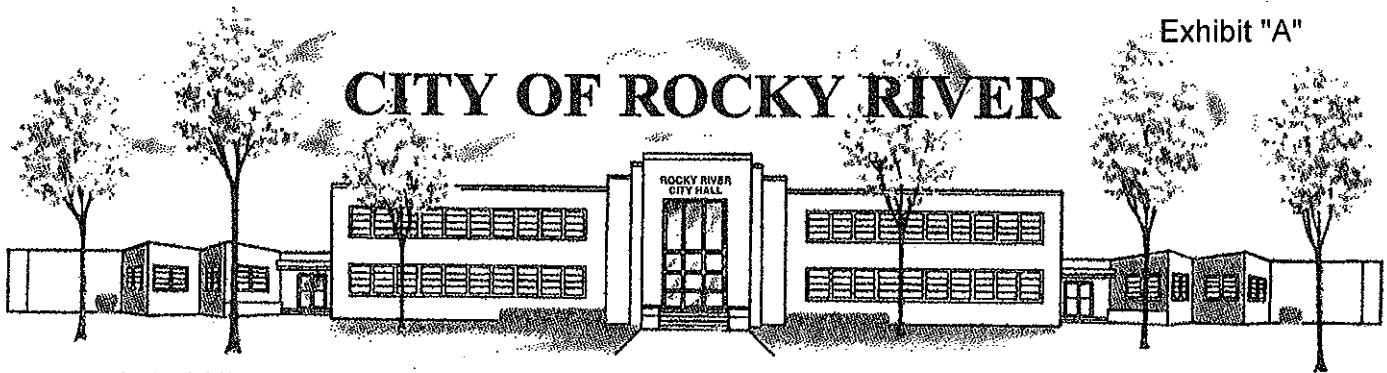

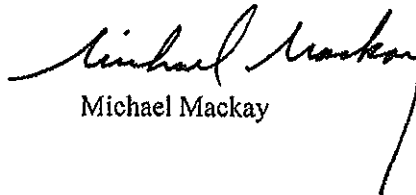
The project includes 4,540 linear feet of cleaning and cement lining of existing 8" and 6" water mains. Utilicon Corporation has the required experience and equipment, and has satisfactorily provided this type of work to the City of Cleveland, Division of Public Utilities, the City of Mayfield Heights and also the City of Rocky River.

Utilicon Corporation has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database that shows they are not listed in the database.

Dear Ms. Costello,

The Cleveland Water Division (CWD) has reviewed the engineering plans and the tabulation of bids received from the City of Rocky River for the Lakeview Avenue Water Main Cleaning and Lining Project. Your community will be reimbursed for the eligible project costs for this project as part of our Suburban Water Main Renewal Program, subject to the terms of your Water Service Agreement.

Our review has not found any major issues with the bids received. Therefore, please consider this letter to be CWD approval of the awarding of the contract to your low bidder, Utilicon Corporation. It is our understanding that the amount to be awarded for the work on Lakeview Road is \$212,949.00, and this is the amount CWD is approving.
