AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, OHIO,
DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016
AND TO AMEND ORD. NO. 77 – 15

WHEREAS: To provide for the current expenses of the City of Rocky River, Ohio, for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016, City Council adopted an annual appropriation ordinance, Ordinance No. 77-15, and;

WHEREAS: The City of Rocky River, Charter, Article VII, Section 6 (1990) provides that City Council may amend or supplement the annual appropriation ordinance after its passage, and;

WHEREAS: The unanticipated financial needs of the City require supplemental appropriations for current expenses as provided in the attached Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

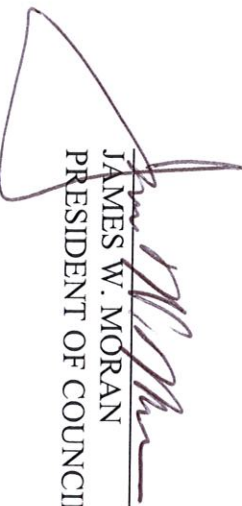
SECTION 1. – That to provide for the current expenses of the City of Rocky River, Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016, the sums provided in the attached Exhibit "A" be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated in addition to the provisions of Ordinance No. 77-15.

SECTION 2. - That Ordinance No. 77-15, regarding appropriations for the current expenses of the City of Rocky River, Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016 is hereby amended.

SECTION 3. - Except as amended in Section 1 of this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 77-15 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that the supplemental appropriations provided for hereby are necessary for the daily operation of municipal departments, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

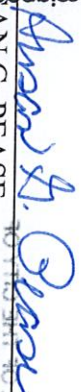

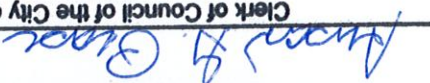
