AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY SERVICE TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF CATIONIC POLYMER FROM POLYDYNE, INC. FOR 2017 FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT A COST OF \$1.40 PER POUND AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that contain an option for annual renewal for the purchase of cationic polymer for the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and,

WHEREAS: one (1) bid was received on October 16, 2015 and after review by the Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent it was determined pursuant to ordinance 69-15 to be the lowest and best bid for cationic polymer, copy of said bid is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and,

WHEREAS: City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to authorize renewing the bid for one (1) year from Polydyne Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Safety-Service is hereby authorized to purchase cationic polymer for 2017 with an option to renew on an annual basis from Polydyne, Inc. at One Chemical Plant Road, Riceboro, GA 31323, the successful bidder for cationic polymer at a cost of \$1.40 per pound for 2017.

SECTION 2: That funds for the purchase of said chemical shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.
