

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE FERRIC CHLORIDE FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT FROM PVS TECHNOLOGIES, INC., AT \$438.33 PER DRY TON FOR 2017 AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that contain an option to renew on an annual basis for the purchase of ferric chloride for the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS: two (2) bids were received on October 16, 2015 and after review by the Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent it was determined pursuant to Ordinance 70-15 the lowest and best bid for ferric chloride, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS: City Council has determined that it in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to authorize renewing the bid for one (1) year for ferric chloride from PVS Technologies, Inc., 10900 Harper Avenue, Detroit, MI 48213.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase ferric chloride for 2017 from PVS Technologies, Inc., 10900 Harper Avenue, Detroit, MI 48213 at \$438.33 per dry ton.

SECTION 2. That funds for the purchase of ferric chloride shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.
