AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FROM DECEMBER 2016 THROUGH 2017 FOR THE REMOVAL OF DIGESTED SLUDGE CAKE TO A MUNICIPAL LANDFILL FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT FROM RUMPKE OF NORTHERN OHIO, INC., AT A COST OF \$42.10 PER TON

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that contain an option to renew on an annual basis for the removal of digested sludge cake to a landfill from the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS: on September 30, 2016, three (3) bids were received and were reviewed by the Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent, a copy of said bids are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service and the Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent have determined that it is the best interest of the City and Wastewater Treatment Plant to accept the lowest and best bid for the removal of digested sludge cake to a municipal landfill from Rumpke of Northern Ohio, Inc., at a cost of \$42.10 per ton for a period of one (1) year with an option to renew on an annual basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase services for the removal of digested sludge cake to a municipal landfill for one (1) year with an option to renew on an annual basis from Rumpke of Northern Ohio, Inc., 10795 Hughes Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45251 at the price of \$42.10 per ton.

SECTION 2. That funds for the removal of digested sludge cake to a municipal landfill shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that services may be purchased at the prevailing price, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
