AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM FOR THE SHORELAND / WOOSTER NEIGHBORHOOD PARK PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City Administration had, with the assistance of the Cuyahoga Land Bank Program, remediated the land at the corner of Shoreland Avenue and Wooster Road; which site is ideal for redevelopment into a public park; and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County has determined that the land at the corner of Shoreland Avenue and Wooster Road is eligible for consideration for a grant from the Cuyahoga County Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, an application for assistance under said County CDBG Program must be submitted by December 23, 2016; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, the maximum amount of funding available through this program for the Shoreland / Wooster Neighborhood Park Project is \$150,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Rocky River hereby authorizes the Mayor or her designee to make application for the project to be funded under the Competitive Municipal Grant Program.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk is hereby authorized to attach a copy of this Resolution to the application for assistance to its filing.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that timely response is necessary to participate in the grant process, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
