AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO PAY ANDREA ROCCO, ESQ. THE SUM OF SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$625.00) FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RENDERED AS SPECIAL PROSECUTOR

WHEREAS: Andrea Rocco, Esq. provided professional legal services as special prosecutor for the City of Rocky River relating to a criminal matter at the Rocky River Municipal Court in 2015; and

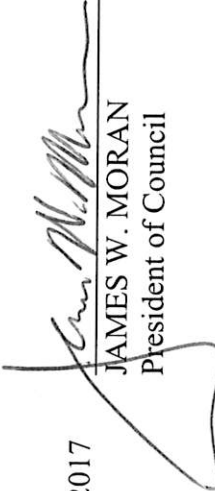
WHEREAS: Attorney Rocco submitted to the City of Rocky River an invoice dated December 16, 2016 for the period of September through November 2015 in the amount of Six Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$625.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Finance Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to pay the invoice submitted by Andrea Rocco, Esq. in the amount of Six Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$625.00), as reflected in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that the amount is due and outstanding and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
