A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY
2017-2022 ALL-HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River, Cuyahoga County, Ohio is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the City of Rocky River; and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1: The Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan, which can be found on Cuyahoga County's website at: https://ready.cuyahogacounty.us/pdf_ready/en-US/Cuyahoga%20AHMP%20FINAL%202017-2022.compressed.pdf, is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the City of Rocky River.

SECTION 2: The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that eligibility to apply for the federal hazard mitigation programs is contingent upon adoption and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
