ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

Bi-Weekly Rate

The respective salaries set forth herein shall be paid in equal bi-weekly installments. To compute the bi-weekly salary, the annual salary shall be divided by the factor of **26**.

Hourly Rate To calculate the hourly rate, the bi-weekly salary shall be divided by a factor of 80 hours. This hourly rate shall be used to calculate the overtime

Hourly Rate - Fire Division

To calculate the hourly rate for employees assigned to platoon duty in the Fire Division, the bi-weekly salary shall be divided by a factor of 99.6 hours.

Overtime

collective bargaining agreements. Union Employees - Specific guidelines covering the payment of overtime compensation and compensatory time are covered in the respective

Non-Union Employees - Overtime compensation and compensatory time for employees not covered by a collective bargaining agreement are

governed by the FLSA and Employee Handbook policy.

Directors, Commissioners, and Chiefs of Divisions and Departments - Wiithin the demands of duties of the office, Directors, Commissioners and Chiefs of Divisions and Departments shall maintain their usual business hours within their respective areas of supervision of city offices and shall be reasonably accessible to the public and City officials. Overtime shall not be paid to Directors, Commissioners, or Chiefs of Divisions and Departments.

Shift Premium Pay

All bargaining unit full-time employees of the Service Department will be paid premimum pay of an additional \$0.50 per hour for all such employees working second, third, and swing shift.

The uniform allowance shall be paid to employees once per year and shall be prorated to the date of termination for any reason.

*Those employees who choose to have uniforms furnished by the City at no cost, shall receive \$450 instead of \$700 annually. Such employees shall notify the City by December 15 of each year of this decision; such notification cannot be changed until the following December.

LONGEVITY

To be eligible for longevity payments, the employee must have five (5) full years of full-time service and be on the active payroll on December 1 of each year. However, benefits will be prorated for an employee who retires with more than 25 years of service, leaves under the disability provisions of the pension program, or dies while still on the active payroll. Prorated benefits shall be payable in a lump sum within 30 days after the separation date to the employee or in the event of death, to the suviving spouse, dependent children or heirs designaed in the estate, in that order named.
