ORDINANCE NO. 27-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH UNITED SURVEY, INC. FOR THE 2017 SANITARY SEWER AND MANHOLE REHABILITATION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$192,720.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2017 Sanitary Sewer and Manhole Rehabilitation which will recondition sanitary sewer lines on sections of Elmwood, Kenwood and Parklawn; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of United Survey, Inc. be accepted at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars and 00/100 (\$192,720.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the 2017 Sanitary Sewer and Manhole Rehabilitation at a cost not to exceed \$192,720.00 with United Survey, Inc., 25145 Broadway Ave., Cleveland, Ohio 44146.

SECTION 2. That \$192,720.00 shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Contractors Account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately because of imperative nature of sewer maintenance and rehabilitation that is essential for the Elmwood, Kensington Parklawn sewer system and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

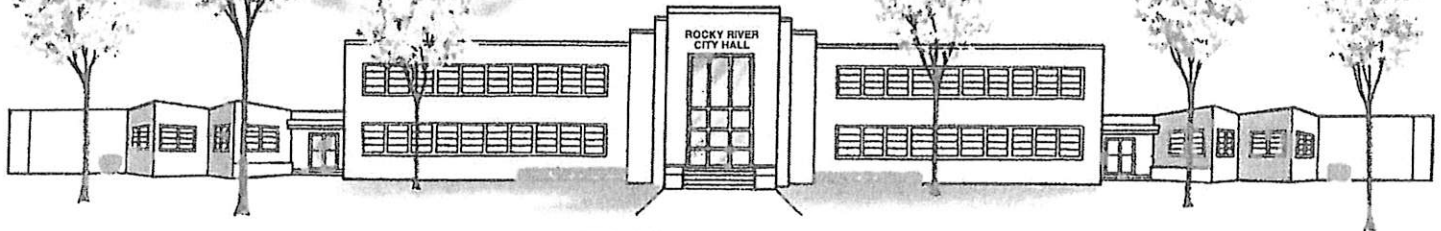

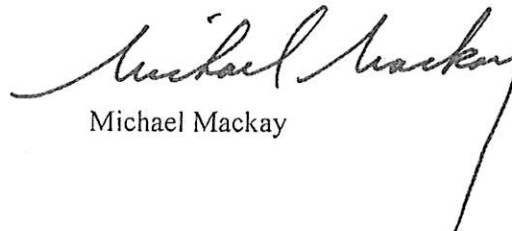
