ORDINANCE NO. 31-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE HAMPTON ROAD (SOUTH) LAKEVIEW AVENUE SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$5,078,920.70

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Hampton Road (South) Lakeview Avenue Sewer Improvement Project; and,

WHEREAS, seven (7) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co., Inc. be accepted at a cost not to exceed Five Million Seventy-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Dollars and 70/100 (\$5,078,920.70).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co., Inc., 389 Columbia Rd., Valley City, Ohio 44280-9799 for the Hampton Road (South) Lakeview Avenue Sewer Improvement Project O.P.W.C. NO. CA11T.

SECTION 2. That \$5,078,920.70 shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Contractors Account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately because of imperative nature of meeting DOPWIC funding deadlines and USEPA requirements and that these the sewer improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

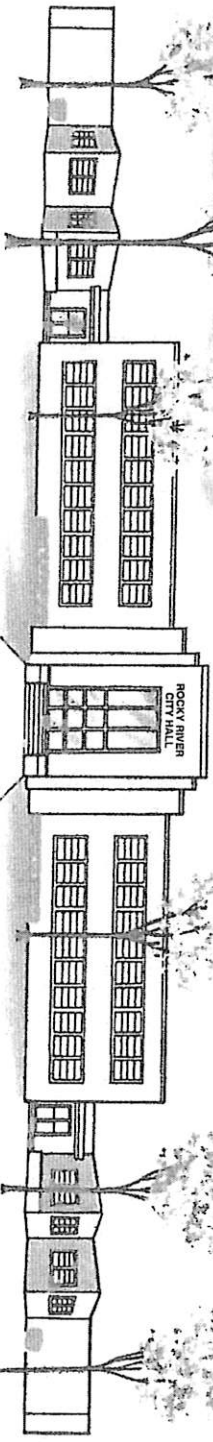
