AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CROSSROADS ASPHALT RECYCLING, INC., FOR THE 2017 STREET REPAIR PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$789,947.40

WHEREAS, the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2017 Street Repair Program which will provide new pavement for the following streets: Buckingham Rd., Elmwood Rd.(from Lake to Avalon), Erie Rd. (west from Elmwood through and including Whitesay Ln.), High Pkwy. (from 18519 High Pkwy. to East Shoreland), Kensington Oval, Morewood Alley East, Orchard Grove Ave. (to Westmoor), Palmer Dr., Smith Ct. (from Ingersoll to South Falmouth / South Kensington), Southbend Circle/Southbend Dr. (street repairs), Stratford Dr., Wooster Pkwy., and City Hall between the Senior Center and Civic Center; and

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Seven Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars and 40/100 (\$789,947.40) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., 13421 Hawke Road, Columbia Station, Ohio 44028 in an amount not to exceed \$789,947.40.

SECTION 2. That the 2017 Street Repair Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund: Resurfacing Paving Contractors account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

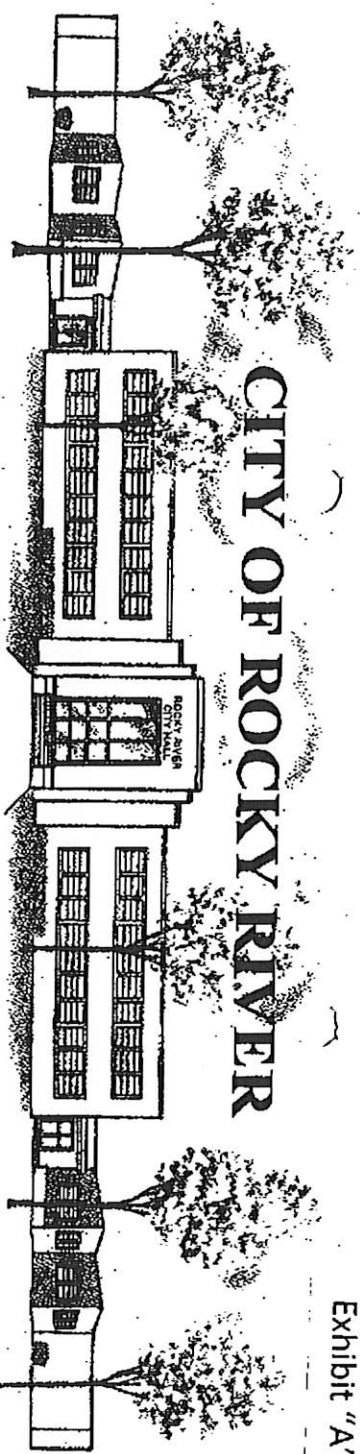
