ORDINANCE NO. 50-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING & PAVING CO., INC. FOR THE 2017/2018 WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR LAUREL DRIVE AND PURNELL AVENUE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,093,755.50

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2017/2018 Water Main Replacement Project for Laurel Drive and Purnell Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Fabrizio Trucking & Paving Co., Inc., be accepted which is not to exceed One Million Ninety-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and 50/100 (\$1,093,755.50) as further explained in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co, Inc., 20389 First Avenue, Middleburg Hts., OH, 44130 for the 2017/2018 Water Main Replacement Project for Laurel Drive and Purnell Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$1,093,755.50.

SECTION 2. That \$1,093,755.50 shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Contractors account.

SECTION 3. That the City will be reimbursed by Cleveland Water Division through the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately because of imperative nature of the maintenance of the water utility and that by immediately commencing work will allow the City to fully use the construction season ahead and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

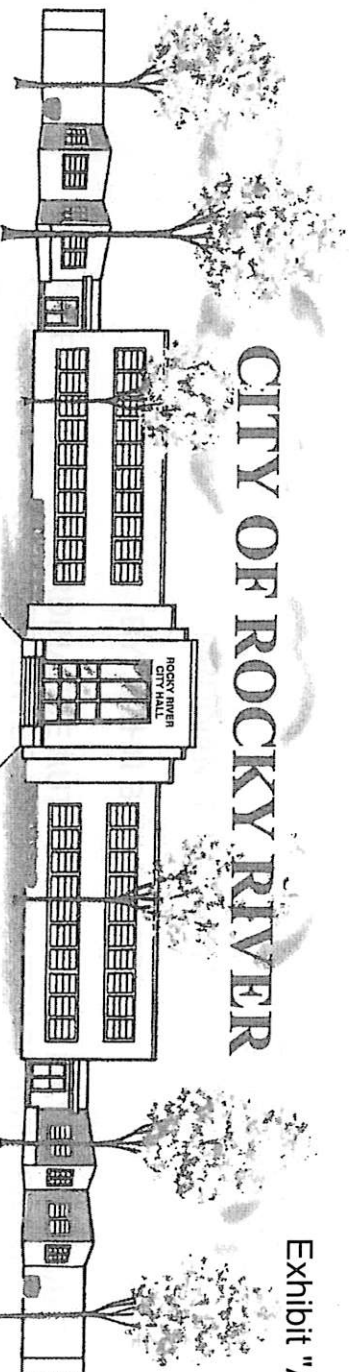

The City received three bids on July 14, 2017 for the 2017/2018 Water Main Replacement for Laurel Avenue and Purnell Avenue.

1. Fabrizio Trucking and Paving Co., Inc.	\$ 1,093,755.50	
2. DiGioia-Suburban Excavating, LLC	\$ 1,237,452.00	\$143,696.50
3. Terrace Construction Company, Inc.	\$ 1,260,852.00	\$167,096.50
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 1,203,000.00	

Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co., Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work to the City of Rocky River and has also completed water main replacement projects in the Cities of Garfield Heights and Brook Park. David Krock, Garfield Heights City Engineer and Ed Platek, Brook Park City Engineer, both gave favorable recommendations for Fabrizio Trucking and Paving Co., Inc.

Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co., Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
