AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND HER
DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE
COORDINATING AGENCY (NOACA), FOR TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE
COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE (TLCI) IMPLEMENTATION, TO FUND IMPROVEMENTS
FOR CENTER RIDGE ROAD AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Rocky River has requested authorization from Rocky River City Council to submit an application to the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) in cooperation with the City of Fairview Park for funding through the Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) Implementation program which grant amount will be determined, and

WHEREAS, the TLCI Implementation program will fund recommended improvements from TLCI study areas that integrate transportation and land use planning, promote livability, and advance the goals of NOACA's Strategic Plan for northeast Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the TLCI program is paid on a reimbursement basis, requiring the applicant to first expend funds and then request reimbursement from NOACA, and

WHEREAS, the applicant certifies it will provide all engineering for the proposed project from sources other than United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) funds, and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River and City of Fairview Park agrees to abide by all federal requirements as a sub-recipient of federal transportation funds, including Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Americans with Disabilities Act, and including all applicable federal procurement requirements, and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River agrees to be responsible for managing any and all subcontracting agencies, organizations, or consultants, and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River agrees to complete the agreed upon scope of services or will forfeit current and future TLCI awards, and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River is authorized to execute a contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and NOACA if awarded a TLCI Implementation grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and her designee be authorized to submit this application to NOACA, acting as designated recipient of USDOT (United States Department of Transportation) funds, for the TLCI Program and to execute a contract with NOACA if selected for funding.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further protection that timely response is necessary to participate in the grant process; with said grant being received on October 6, 2017, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date of approval allowed by law.
