ORDINANCE NO. 70-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KONSTRUCTION KING, INC. FOR THE 2017 CATCH BASIN PROGRAM AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$368,610.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2017 Catch Basin Program which will recondition catch basins and sanitary sewer manholes on sections of Archwood, Beverly Hills, Chrisfield, Delmar, Hilliard Blvd., Marlys, Stratford, Sunnyhill, Thomson, and Vine Court; and

WHEREAS, four (4) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Konstruktion King, Inc. be accepted at a cost not to exceed Three Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand Six Hundred Ten Dollars and 00/100 (\$368,610.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the 2017 Catch Basin Program at a cost not to exceed \$368,610.00 with Konstruktion King, Inc., 1270 West 130th Street Unit 300, Brunswick, Ohio 44212.

SECTION 2. That \$368,610.00 shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Contractors Account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately because of imperative nature of sewer maintenance and rehabilitation that is essential for the potential emergency maintenance of sanitary system and the efficient collection of storm water, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

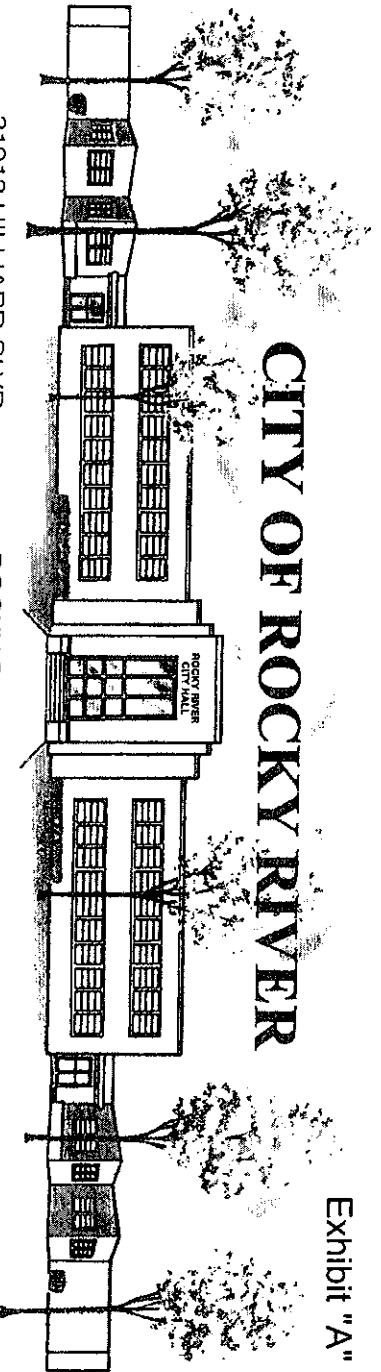

The City received four bids on September 15, 2017 for the 2017 Rocky River Catch Basin Program.

4. Chagrin Valley Paving	\$634,700.00	\$266,090.00

Engineer's Estimate \$380,000.00

Konstruktion King, Inc. has previously satisfactorily completed projects in the City of Fairview Park and City of Middleburg Heights. Konstruktion King, Inc. is ODOT pre-qualified and has provided work of this nature to the City of Brecksville, the City of Strongsville and the City of Parma Heights. We contacted Becki Riser with the City of Brecksville, Don Zack with the City of Strongsville and C.J. Onyak with the City of Parma and all provided favorable references for Konstruktion King, Inc.

Konstruktion King, Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a certified search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
