

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE
SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT WITH
FABRIZI TRUCKING & PAVING CO., INC. FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR
OF STREETS AND STORM AND SANITARY SEWERS WITHIN THE CITY OF
ROCKY RIVER AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000.00 AS FURTHER
DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the emergency repair of streets and storm and sanitary sewers within the City of Rocky River in February of 2011 and (1) bid was received on March 4, 2011 from Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS: In Ordinance 10-11 City Council had determined that it was in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to accept the bid and enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co. for emergency repair of streets and storm and sanitary sewers and in Ordinance 68-16 City Council accepted the renewal of the agreement for said repairs with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc.

WHEREAS: Due to infrastructure conditions that were undetectable, emergency sewer and street repairs have caused the need to extend the agreement with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving for 2017 at the same costs and not to exceed Ninety Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$90,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc., 20389 First Avenue, Middleburg Hts., OH, 44130, for the emergency repair of streets and storm and sanitary sewers for 2017 at a total net cost not to exceed Ninety Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$90,000.00) with prices for said service further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That funds for the payment of said services shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and that said services to repair failed sewers may be secured at the prevailing prices, and for the further reason that the current emergency sewer repairs require immediate attention and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
