

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO RENEW A CONTRACT FOR VARIOUS INSURANCE COVERAGES FOR THE ROCKY RIVER MUNICIPAL COURT WITH JACKSON DIEKEN & ASSOCIATES FOR THE YEAR 2018 AT A TOTAL COST OF \$9,664.00

WHEREAS: pursuant to ordinance 83-14, City Council determined that it was in the best interest of the Rocky River Municipal Court to accept the insurance proposal which include offers for annual renewals from Jackson, Dieken & Associates; in Ordinance 79-15 and 71-16 City Council exercised its offer to renew the same insurance coverage for 2016 and 2017; and

WHEREAS: the Mayor and Director of Public Safety-Service have determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to exercise its offer to renew for the additional year of the 2018 contract for insurance coverages for the Rocky River Municipal Court from Jackson Dieken & Associates, 27893 Clemens Road, Westlake, Ohio 44145.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a renewal of insurance coverages, which is the 2nd year of a 3 year rate guarantee, if the Court has a loss ratio of 24% or less at 21 months, for the purchase of General Liability Insurance, Property Insurance, Public Officials, Employment Practices, Employers Liability (Stop Gap Liability), Blanket Position Bonds, Blanket Bond/Crime, Law Enforcement Liability, Excess Liability, EDP/Property Floater, Valuable Papers and Business Auto Liability for the Rocky River Municipal Court facility for 2018 at a total cost of Nine Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$9,664.00) through Jackson Dieken & Associates and Tokio Marine HCC Public Risk, as underwritten by U.S. Specialty Insurance Company.

SECTION 2. That the net cost of the purchase of this insurance shall be appropriated and paid from the General Fund: Judges - Insurance and Court-Insurance and the RRMCM Computer Fund A and RRMCM Computer Fund B.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason to keep current the contract for this service and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
