AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND HER DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREA WIDE COORDINATING AGENCY (NOACA) FOR ITS ENHANCED MOBILITY FOR SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES (SECTION 5310) PROGRAM GRANT FOR A TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE FOR THE ROCKY RIVER SENIOR CENTER

WHEREAS, this program provides capital grants to assist governments, transit agencies, and other transportation providers who offer coordinated transportation services that are planned, designed, and carried out to meet the needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities in the Cleveland urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, if requested funds are granted, the City of Rocky River shall be responsible for at least twenty (20%) percent of the eligible costs; and

WHEREAS, to provide for the current expenses for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018, with Amended Ordinance No. 97-17 City Council appropriated \$30,000.00 for a new Senior Transportation vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River certifies that the City is a governmental authority and that no public or nonprofit corporation or associations are readily available in the proposed service area to adequately provide the service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and her designee be authorized to submit an application for funds and to submit same to the NOACA for consideration of funding for its Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals With Disabilities (Section 5310) Program Grant for a vehicle for the Rocky River Senior Center.

SECTION 2. The total estimated cost of the purchase is \$75,000.00; 80% of the estimated costs will be eligible for grant funding (\$60,000.00) and 20% of the estimated costs (\$15,000.00) will be paid by the City.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that timely response by February 2, 2018 is necessary to participate in the NOACA application grant process, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
