AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SHELLY COMPANY FOR THE 2018/2019 DETROIT ROADWOOSTER ROAD OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) RESURFACING PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,171,296.66

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2018/2019 Detroit Road/Wooster Road ODOT Resurfacing Project CUY US 020-08.01/VAR PID 85393 which will provide new pavement for Wooster Road from Center Ridge to Detroit and Detroit Road from the Westlake corporation line; and

WHEREAS, seven (7) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of The Shelly Company, 8920 Canyon Falls Blvd., STE 120, Twinsburg, OH 44087-1973 be accepted which is not to exceed Three Million One Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and 66/100 (\$3,171,296.66) as further explained in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Shelly Company, 8920 Canyon Falls Blvd., STE 120, Twinsburg, OH 44087-1973 for the 2018/2019 Detroit Road/Wooster Road ODOT Resurfacing Project CUY US 020-08.01/VAR PID 85393 in an amount not to exceed \$3,171,296.66.

SECTION 2. That \$3,171,296.66 shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund – Paving Contractors account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
