AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 2018 FORD INTERCEPTOR FOR THE POLICE DIVISION UNDER THE STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ACT FROM LEBANON FORD AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$29,504.40

WHEREAS: Council passed Resolution 20-88 on March 21, 1988 authorizing the Administration to participate in the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act; and,

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to purchase one (1) 2018 Ford Interceptor at a total cost not to exceed \$29,504.40 for the Police Division from Lebanon Ford, under the State Cooperative Purchasing Act, under which the State of Ohio publicly bids vehicles for governmental use, as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety-Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 2018 Ford Interceptor vehicle at a total cost not to exceed Twenty Nine Thousand Five Hundred Four Dollars and 40/100 (\$29,504.40), from Lebanon Ford, 770 Columbus Ave., Lebanon, Ohio 45036, under the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act.

SECTION 2. That \$29,504.40 for one (1) vehicle shall be paid for from the General Fund – POPAS Police Cars account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to participate timely in the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing program, at the State's prevailing price and for the further reason that it is necessary for the Police Division, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
