AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND HER DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A \$150,000.00 NATUREWORKS GRANT AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR BRADSTREET'S LANDING PARK PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS: the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) , Office of Real Estate, administers financial assistance for the Natureworks Grant program; and

WHEREAS: the City of Rocky River desires financial assistance under the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Natureworks grant program; and

WHEREAS: the most competitive of Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Natureworks grant program applications include a minimum of 25% of the total project cost to improve accessibility to Lake Erie by installing a new pedestrian bridge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Cable Franchise fees – dedicated to parks improvements, capital funds from income tax to be used and leveraged with State Capital funding, County Community Improvement funds and future Coastal Management Assistance Grant funding shall be appropriated in the Parks Improvement-Bradstreet's Account.

SECTION 2. That Rocky River City Council hereby approves the filing of an application for financial assistance and entering into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Natureworks Grant program.

SECTION 3. That City Council hereby ratifies and authorizes the actions of the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service taken to execute and file an application and enter into agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources regarding the Natureworks grant and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 4. That this Council agrees to appropriate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project, including as part of the application a local match equaling at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the proposed project, and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Natureworks Grant Program.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and for the further reason that the application submission date to the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources was June 1, 2018 for review and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
