AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
AND/OR THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE ONE
(1) 2019 LADDER TRUCK FOR THE FIRE DIVISION FROM
SUTPHEN CORPORATION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED
\$1,199,929.00

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the purchase of one (1) ladder truck for the City of Rocky River Fire Division; and

WHEREAS: three (3) bids were received for the fire truck, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to accept the bid for a new ladder truck for the Fire Division, from Sutphen Corporation, 6450 Eiterman Road, Dublin, OH 43016, as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and/or the Safety-Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 2019 fire ladder truck at a total cost not to exceed One Million One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and 00/100 (\$1,199,929.00).

SECTION 2. That \$1,199,929.00 shall be paid from the Equipment Purchase Fund – Vehicle Purchase account.

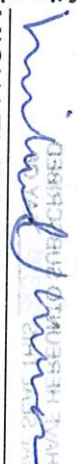
SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to update the Fire Division vehicle fleet (replacing the totaled 1992 vehicle) and to authorize the facility the vehicle's manufacturing process, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

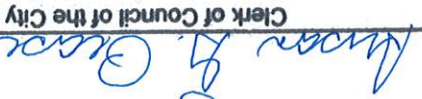
