AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MAYOR'S OR HER DESIGNEE'S APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION'S STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM(S) FOR THE COLLVER ROAD / OAK ROAD / MOREWOOD PARKWAY (FROM WAGAR TO RAILROAD TRACKS) STORM AND SANITARY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program under the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River is planning to make capital improvements via the project known as the Collver Road / Oak Road / Morewood Parkway (Wagar to Railroad) storm and sanitary improvement replacement project which will eliminate storm water infiltration by replacing inverted sewers that allow storm water to infiltrate the aging sanitary sewer system and is ultimately causing: surcharged lines and severe basement flooding; sanitary sewer overflows at Waste Water Treatment plant and this project will replace broken sewer pipe in the City's system; and,

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements described herein are considered to be an environmental priority need for the City and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs; and,

WHEREAS, the application for said infrastructure improvements must be submitted by September 24, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Rocky River hereby ratifies the Mayor's or her Designee's to participate in the OPWC State Capital Improvement and / or Local Transportation Programs(s) for the Collver Road / Oak Road / Morewood Parkway (Wagar to Railroad) Storm and Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project as described herein.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor or her Designee are further ratified to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining the requested financial assistance.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed for implementation in a timely manner, and provided it gives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
