AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT WITH JAMES DIAZ TO PURCHASE SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF DIGESTED SLUDGE CAKE FROM THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT A COST OF \$22.00 PER WET TON FOR 2019 AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that allow annual renewals for the removal of digested sludge cake from the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS: on January 26, 2018, two (2) bids were received for the removal of digested sludge cake and copies of said bids are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS: after review by the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent and the Director of Public Safety-Service, it was determined that the lowest and best bid which allows annual renewals for one (1) year was from James Diaz, 660 State Route 58, Sullivan, Ohio, at \$22.00 per wet ton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase services for the removal of digested sludge cake through 2019 from James Diaz, 660 State Route 58, Sullivan, Ohio, at \$22.00 per ton.

SECTION 2. That funds for the removal of digested sludge cake shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.
