AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERK COMPANY, INC., FOR THE 2018 TREE AND SIDEWALK PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$157,896.00

WHEREAS, the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2018 Tree and Sidewalk Program which will provide sidewalk repairs and new tree lawn trees for Archwood and Mariys Drive; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from Perk Company, Inc., be accepted in the amount of One Hundred and Fifty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-Six Dollars and 00/100 (\$157,896.00) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Perk Company, Inc., 8100 Grand Avenue, Cleveland, OH 44104 in an amount not to exceed \$157,896.00.

SECTION 2. That the 2018 Tree and Sidewalk Program, shall be paid from the Sidewalk Paving Contractors account of the Capital Projects Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

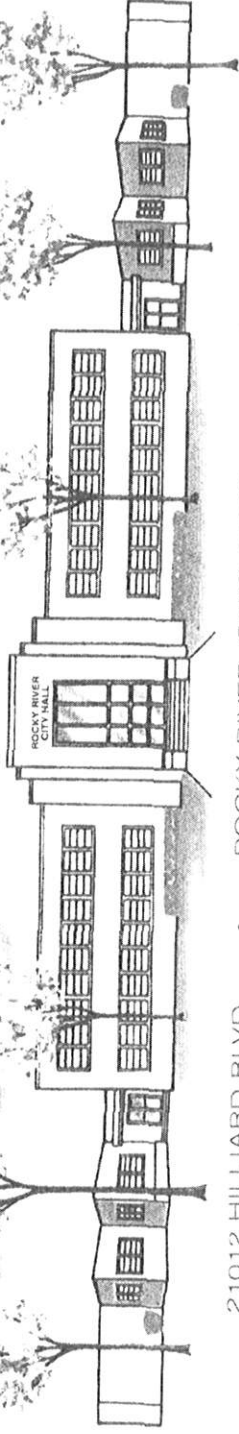

We received two bids on September 28, 2018 for the 2018 Rocky River Street Repair Program.

1. Perk Company, Inc.	\$ 157,896.00	\$ 0.00
2. Catts Construction, Inc.	\$ 196,986.00	\$ 49,090.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 200,000.00	

Perk Company, Inc. has previously worked in the City of Middleburg Heights and satisfactorily completed the project. Perk Company, Inc. has also previously worked on similar projects in several nearby communities including the City of Strongsville and the City of Lakewood. The City of Strongsville and the City of Lakewood both provided favorable references for Perk Company, Inc.

Perk Company, Inc. has completed all the required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a certified search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
