ORDINANCE NO. 82-18

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO PAY COURTVIEW JUSTICE SOLUTIONS, INC. THE SUM OF FIFTY SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY TWO DOLLARS (\$57,442.00) FOR THE COST OF SUPPORT SERVICES FOR VARIOUS SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS FOR THE ROCKY RIVER MUNICIPAL COURT AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Clerk of Court and the Municipal Court Systems Administrator have determined it is in the best interest of the Rocky River Municipal Court to continue to purchase the software support services for its various proprietary case management software applications from the incumbent software provider and,

WHEREAS: City of Rocky River, Charter, Article VII, Section 4 provides that City Council may authorize expenditures without public bidding for products, services and emergency repair including labor and material.

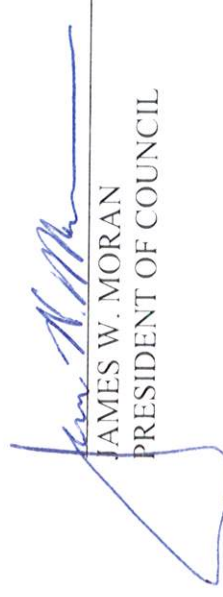
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. – That the Director of Finance of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to pay the invoice amount submitted by CourtView Justice Systems, Inc. in the amount of fifty seven thousand four hundred forty two dollars (\$57,442.00), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. – That the funds for this purchase shall be paid from the Rocky River Municipal Court Computer A and Rocky River Municipal Computer B Funds.

SECTION 2. – That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that technology contributes to an efficient municipal court operation and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

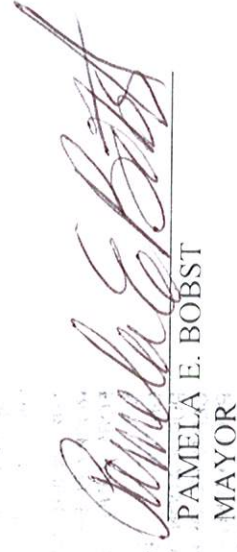

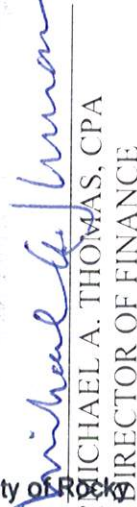
