AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CUYAHOGA COUNTY TO RECEIVE FUNDING FROM THE 2019 CUYAHOGA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT (CDSG) PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00 FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE HILLIARD/WAGAR INTERSECTION FOR PEDESTRIAN SIGNALS AND CROSSWALKS AND THE MID-BLOCK CROSSWALK ACROSS HILLIARD AT THE OUTDOOR POOL AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY WALKS AT ROCKY RIVER CITY CAMPUS

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River has applied for a grant in the sum of \$50,000.00 to fund crosswalk safety for improvements at the Hilliard/Wagar intersection for pedestrian signals and crosswalks and the mid-block crosswalk across Hilliard at the outdoor pool and pedestrian safety walks at Rocky River City Campus; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends City Council approval to enter into an agreement with Cuyahoga County to provide funding for the improvement of crosswalk safety at the Hilliard/Wagar intersection for pedestrian signals and crosswalks and the mid-block crosswalk across Hilliard at the outdoor pool and pedestrian safety walks at Rocky River City Campus from the CDSG Program; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County CDSG Program will reimburse the City \$50,000.00 for expenses related to this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. Council hereby approves the Mayor entering into an agreement with Cuyahoga County for funding for the 2019 improvement of crosswalk safety at the Hilliard/Wagar intersection for pedestrian signals and crosswalks and the mid-block crosswalk across Hilliard at the outdoor pool and pedestrian safety walks at Rocky River City Campus in the amount of \$50,000.00.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that timely response is necessary to participate in the grant process, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
