AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 951.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, REGARDING CITY SWIMMING POOL FEES AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2016 through Ordinance No. 8-16 Rocky River City Council and the Mayor approved the current swimming pool fee schedule for the Rocky River recreational pool users, as provided in Rocky River Codified Ordinance 951.01, entitled "City Swimming Pool".

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Administration and Council of the City of Rocky River that Section 951.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Rocky River be amended to reflect increases for user pool fees in order to cover expanding costs as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 951.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Rocky River be amended as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

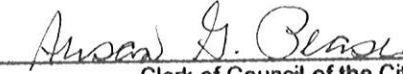

V. DEFINITIONS

Senior:

Rocky River Resident age 60 or older, must present proof of age and residence

Adult:

Age 18 or older and not in senior high school as of June 1st.

Student:

Ages 5-17 and/or student as of June 1 in elementary, junior or senior high school, or 18 and still in high school

Child:

Ages 3-4

Infant:

Age 2 and under as of June 1

Family:

Up to 2 adults residing at the same address, their children of whom they are legal guardians who are under 18 or still in high school. Full-time college students with current college ID's, ages 18-22, will be considered part of the family plan.

Corporate Non-Resident Rocky River Business employee:

Must be non-resident and an employee of a Rocky River business and provide appropriate verification of employment.

Friends and Family:

Friends or family members of Civic Center members or resident pool pass holders that are recommended by the Civic Center members or resident pool pass holders for a pool membership. A maximum of 200 passes will be sold for Friends and Family.
