ORDINANCE NO. 38-19

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF  
THE DIRECTOR OF LAW FOR THE YEARS COMMENCING  
JANUARY 1, 2020 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY  
RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

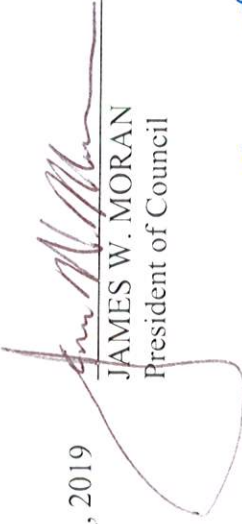
SECTION 1. That the salary of the Director of Law shall be Sixty Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$60,500.00) for the year commencing January 1, 2020 and ending December 31, 2020, and Sixty Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$60,500.00) for the year commencing January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021, for which he shall serve the Mayor, the Council, the administrative officers and departments and commissions and boards of the City as legal counsel.

SECTION 2. In addition to the salary set forth in Section 1. above, the Director of Law shall receive additional compensation at the rate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per hour for all legal services rendered by him in representing the City, the Mayor, the Council, the administrative officers and departments, and the City's commissions and boards in all administrative and court proceedings. The additional compensation set forth in this section shall not exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per year for the years commencing January 1, 2020 and ending December 31, 2021.

SECTION 3. In addition to the salary and additional compensation set forth in Sections 1. and 2. above, the Director of Law shall be entitled to receive additional compensation at the rate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per hour for all legal services rendered by him in representing any organization of governments, special unit of government, or joint undertaking of governments, in which the City is a member or participant, provided that the funds for payment of such compensation are authorized and are provided in accordance with the rules, by-laws, or governing regulations of the organization or entity and further provided that the past practice of crediting the City's share of such fees without additional cost to the City is continued.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that said compensation must be set forty-five (45) days prior to the last filing date of nominating petitions in accordance with Article III Section 11 of the Charter of the City of Rocky River, and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
