ORDINANCE NO. 41-19

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 2019 CHEVROLET MALIBU VEHICLE FOR THE SENIOR CENTER UNDER THE STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ACT FROM GANLEY CHEVROLET OF AURORA LLC, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$18,007.74

WHEREAS: Council passed Resolution 20-88 on March 21, 1988 authorizing the Administration to participate in the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act; and,

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to purchase one (1) 2019 Chevrolet Malibu vehicle at a cost not to exceed \$18,007.74 for the Senior Center from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora LLC, under the State Cooperative Purchasing Act, under which the State of Ohio publicly bids vehicles for governmental use annually, as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety-Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 2019 Chevrolet Malibu vehicle at a cost not to exceed Eighteen Thousand Seven Dollars and 74/100 (\$18,007.74), from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora LLC, 310 West Garfield, Aurora, OH 44202 under the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act.

SECTION 2. That \$18,007.74 for one (1) vehicle shall be paid for from the Equipment Purchase Fund – Vehicle Purchase Account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to participate timely in the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing program, at the State's prevailing price and for the further reason that it is necessary for the Senior Center, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

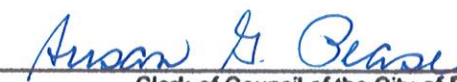

The respective bid response, including the Instructions to Bidders, Standard Terms and Conditions, (Revised 01/2018), supplemental terms and conditions, special contract terms & conditions, any bid addenda, specifications, pricing schedules and any attachments incorporated by reference and accepted by DAS become a part of this Requirements Contract.

This Requirements Contract is effective beginning and ending on the dates noted above unless, prior to the expiration date, the Contract is renewed, terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Contract Terms and Conditions.

CONTRACT RENEWAL. This Contract may be renewed after the ending date of the Contract solely at the discretion of the Contracting Agency for a period of one month. Any further renewals will be by mutual agreement between the Contractor and the Contracting Agency for any number of times and for any period of time. The cumulative time of all mutual renewals may not exceed 24 months unless the Contracting Agency determines that additional renewal is necessary.

This Requirements Contract is available to all State agencies, State institutions of higher education and properly registered members of the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as applicable.

Agencies are eligible to make purchases of the listed supplies and/or services in any amount and at any time as determined by the agency. The State makes no representation or guarantee that agencies will purchase the volume of supplies and/or services as advertised in the Invitation to Bid.
