AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CROSSROAD ASPHALT RECYCLING, INC. FOR THE 2019/2020 HILLIARD BOULEVARD RESURFACING PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,975,960.75

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2019/2020 Hilliard Boulevard Resurfacing Project which will provide new pavement for Hilliard Boulevard from Westlake City Corporation Line to Westmoor Road in the City of Rocky River, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Crossroads Asphalt Recycling Inc., 13412 Hawke Road, Columbia Station, OH 44028 be accepted which is not to exceed One Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty Dollars and 75/100 (\$1,975,960.75) as further explained in Exhibit "A", and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 70-18, City Council authorized the Mayor to enter in an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works to fund 80% of the paving project and 60% of the engineering / design costs for a portion of the paving project (up to \$1,452,000 for paving).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Crossroads Asphalt Recycling Inc., 13412 Hawke Road, Columbia Station, OH 44028 for the 2019/2020 Hilliard Boulevard Resurfacing Project in an amount not to exceed \$1,975,960.75.

SECTION 2. That \$1,975,960.75 shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund - Paving Contractors account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
