ORDINANCE NO. 50-19

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 2019 SENIOR MOBILITY VEHICLE WITH 15 TOTAL PASSENGER CAPACITY FOR THE SENIOR CENTER FROM AMERICAN BUS & ACCESSORIES, INC., AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$83,885.00

WHEREAS: the City was authorized in Resolution 85-18 to enter into an agreement with the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) to provide 80% of funding (up to \$60,000) for the purchase of a vehicle for enhanced mobility for the Rocky River Senior Center; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Senior Center Mobility Vehicle; and,

WHEREAS: two (2) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A", copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service recommends that the lowest and best bid from American Bus & Accessories, Inc. be accepted at a cost not to exceed Eighty Three Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Five Dollars and 00/100 (\$83,885.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety-Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 2019 Senior Mobility Vehicle at a cost not to exceed Eighty Three Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Five Dollars and 00/100 (\$83,885.00) from American Bus and Accessories, 123 City Centre Drive, Cincinnati, OH 45216.

SECTION 2. That the cost of \$83,885.00 for one (1) vehicle shall be paid as follows: \$60,000 from the Equipment Purchase Fund-Vehicle Purchase account and \$23,885.00 from the Donations & Bequests Fund – Senior Center account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to participate timely in the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing program, at the State's prevailing price and for the further reason that it is necessary for the Senior Center, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
