AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 75-19

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERRAM ELECTRIC, INC., FOR THE 2019 SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL (CUY-SRTS FY 2020) LAKEVIEW AVENUE/LAKEVIEW COURT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,925.00

WHEREAS, the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2019 Safe Routes to School (Cuy-SRTS FY 2020) Lakeview Avenue/Lakeview Court Project; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from Perram Electric, Inc., 6882 Ridge Road, Wadsworth, OH 44281 be accepted in the amount of Fifty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and 00/100 (\$54,925.00) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Perram Electric, Inc. 6882 Ridge Road, Wadsworth, OH 44281 in an amount not to exceed \$54,925.00.

SECTION 2. That the 2019 Safe Routes to School (Cuy-SRTS FY 2020), shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund from the Resurfacing Paving Contractors account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

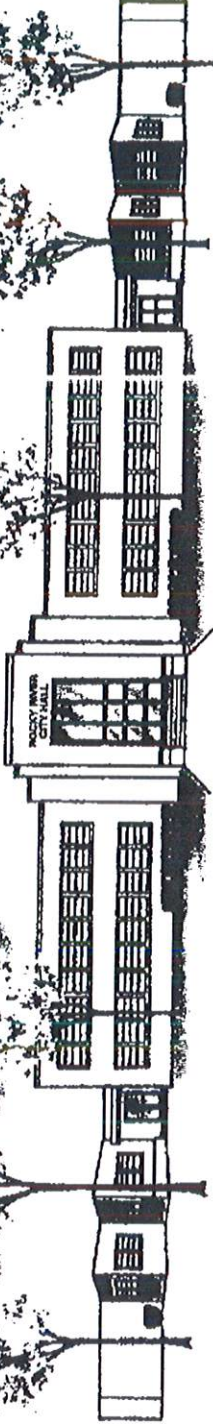

The City received three bids on September 13, 2019 for the CUY-SRTS FY 2020 PID 103714 Lakeview Avenue/Lakeview Court project.

<u>Contractor</u>	<u>Bid</u>	<u>Difference</u>
1. Perram Electric, Inc.	\$ 54,925.00	
2. The R.J. Platten Contracting Co.	\$ 56,963.00	\$ 2,038.00
3. Perk Company, Inc.	\$ 61,150.00	\$ 6,225.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 57,500.00	

Perram Electric, Inc. has the required experience, equipment and has previously worked on traffic signal and pavement marking projects in several nearby communities. Shawn Luningger (City of Fairview Park's Director of Public Service & Development), Jane Cullen, (City of Sandusky's assistant engineer), and Allen Pennington (City of Mentor's traffic engineer) gave Perram Electric, Inc. very favorable recommendations. Perram Electric, Inc. is also an ODOT pre-qualified contractor for maintenance of traffic, signing, highway lighting, traffic signals, pavement markings, miscellaneous concrete and temporary soil erosion and sediment control.

Perram Electric, Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database does not listed them in the database.
