AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND HER DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A \$100,000.00 GRANT FOR A COASTAL MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE GRANT (CMAG) UNDER THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES' OHIO COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM, AND IF GRANTED, TO ACCEPT SAID GRANT

WHEREAS: the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management, administers financial assistance for coastal management purposes, through the Ohio Coastal Management Program, and

WHEREAS: the City of Rocky River compiled a CMAG Master Plan for Bradstreet's Landing Park in 2018 which included in the implementation of this project for a new, fully accessible pedestrian bridge to access Lake Erie and its beaches which the City desires financial assistance for under the Coastal Management Assistance Grant (CMAG) program; and

WHEREAS: it is deemed to be in the best interests of the City to pursue a grant request for \$100,000.00 through the Coastal Management Assistance Grant Program (CMAG), and the City will match 50% of said funds and absorb the remaining costs of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Rocky River City Council hereby ratifies the filing of an application for financial assistance under Coastal Management Assistance.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service are hereby authorized to enter into any resulting agreements with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 3. That this Council agrees to appropriate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project, including as part of the application a local match for the proposed project, and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Coastal Management Assistance Grant Program.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and for the further reason that the application must be submitted by December 13, 2019 for review and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

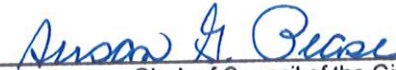
