ORDINANCE NO. 104-20

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH KIMBLE COMPANY FOR THE YEAR 2021 FOR THE REMOVAL OF GRIT AND SCREENINGS FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT A COST OF \$71.75 PER TON AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: The Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that contain an option to renew on an annual basis for the removal of grit and screenings from the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS: Three (3) bids were received on November 30, 2020, and upon recommendation of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent, it was determined to be in the best interest of the City to accept the lowest and best bid from Kimble Company, for the removal of grit and screenings from the Wastewater Treatment Plant for the year 2021, copies of bids are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase services for the removal of grit and screenings from the Wastewater Treatment Plant for the year 2021, with an option to renew from Kimble Company, 3596 State Route 39 NW, Dover, Ohio 44622 at the price of \$71.75 per ton.

SECTION 2. That funds for the removal of grit and screenings shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that the current contract will expire on December 31, 2020, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law

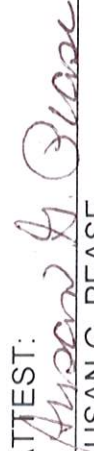

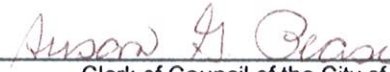

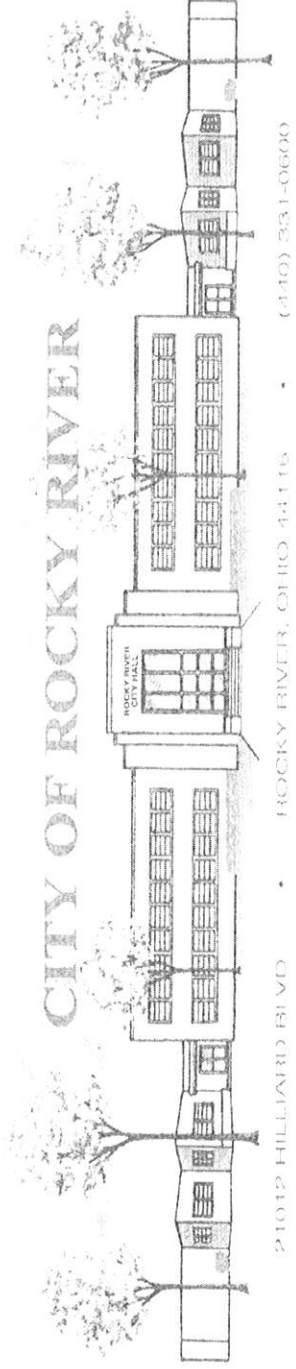

1. Kimble Company	\$ 71.75
2. The Pen Ohio Corp	\$ 79.20
3. Midwest Compost	\$ 94.00 (\$44/ton plus \$500 per box haul)
