AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GREAT LAKES CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE 2020 RIVERDALE DRIVE WIDENING PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$832,553.50 INCLUDING ALL ALTERNATIVES

WHEREAS: the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2020 Riverdale Drive Widening Project and six (6) responses were received on April 10, 2020, copies of which are available at the Safety Service office; and

WHEREAS: the AECOM consulting engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from Great Lakes Construction Company, 2608 Great Lakes Way, Hinckley, Ohio 44233 be accepted, including all alternatives, which is not to exceed Eight Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars and 50/100 (\$832,553.50) as further explained in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Great Lakes Construction Company, 2608 Great Lakes Way, Hinckley, Ohio 44233 for the 2020 Riverdale Drive Widening Project in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars and 50/100 (\$832,553.50) including all alternatives.

SECTION 2. That \$832,553.50 shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvements Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
