ORDINANCE NO. 60-20

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RMH CONCRETE, INC., FOR THE 2020 TREE AND SIDEWALK PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$82,271.70

WHEREAS, the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2020 Tree and Sidewalk Program which will provide sidewalk repairs and removal of conflicting trees for Sunnyhill Drive and Thompson Circle; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from RMH Concrete, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Eighty Two Thousand Two Hundred Seventy One Dollars and 70/100 (\$82,271.70) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with RMH Concrete, Inc., 4433 West Collins Road, Collins, OH 44826 in an amount not to exceed \$82,271.70.

SECTION 2. That the 2020 Tree and Sidewalk Program, shall be paid from the Sidewalks account of the Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

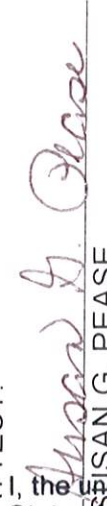

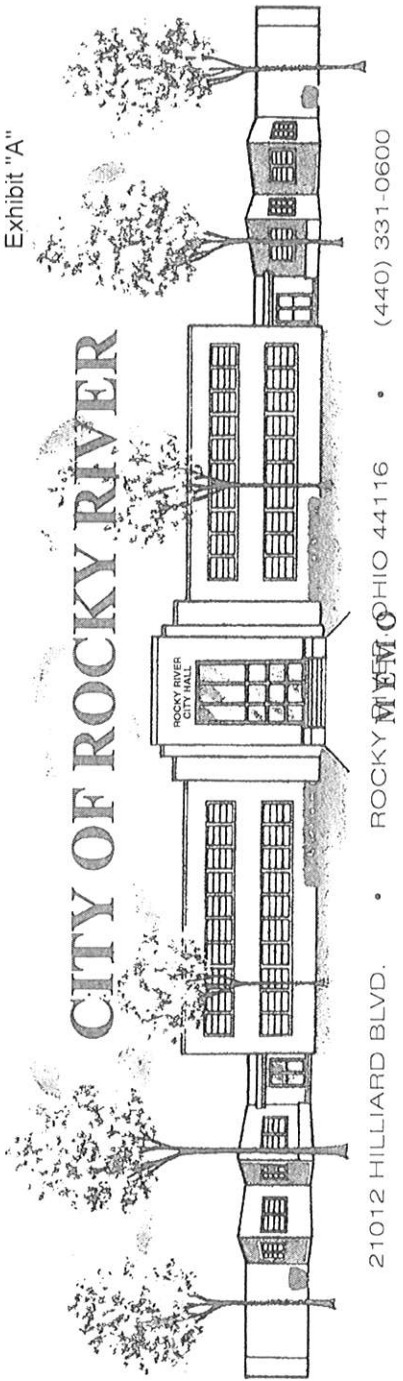

The City received three bids on June 26, 2020 for the 2020 Tree and Sidewalk Program.

RMH Concrete, Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work to the City of Rocky River and has also completed projects in the City of Perrysburg and City of Mansfield. Bob Bianchi from the City of Mansfield provided a favorable reference.

RMH Concrete, Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
