ORDINANCE NO. 63-20

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SHELLY COMPANY, FOR THE 2020 STREET REPAIR PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$691,320.25

WHEREAS, the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2020 Street Repair Program which will provide street and or curb repairs for the following streets: Archwood Drive, Eastlook Road, Eldora Road, Harwich Court, Idlewild Drive, Kingsbury Drive, Marllys Drive, Middle Post Lane, Old Detroit Entrance, Scenic Road, Shoreland Avenue, Westhaven Lane and Wynwood Drive Cul-de-sac; and

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from The Shelly Company, be accepted in the amount of Six Hundred Ninety One Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Dollars and 25/100 (\$691,320.25) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Shelly Company, 8920 Canyon Falls Blvd., Suite 120, Twinsburg, Ohio 44087 for the 2020 Street Repair Program in an amount not to exceed \$691,320.25.

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2020 Street Repair Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

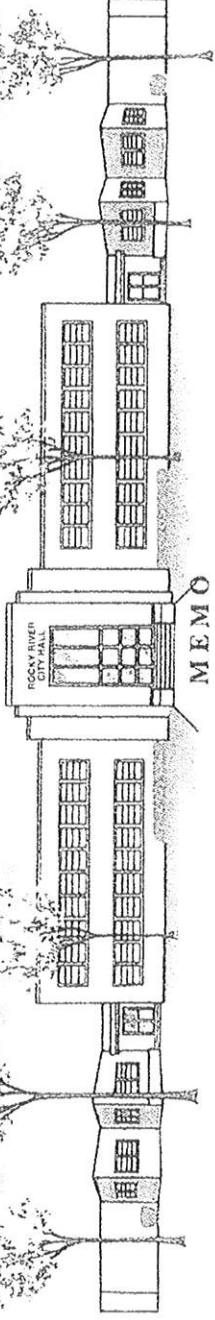

The Shelly Company has previously worked in the City of Rocky River and the City of Fairview Park and satisfactorily completed the projects. The Shelly Company has also previously worked on street repair programs in several nearby communities including the City of Elyria. The City of Elyria provided a favorable reference for The Shelly Company.

The Shelly Company has completed all the required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a certified search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
