ORDINANCE NO. 7-20

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE NO. 95-19 AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO PURCHASE FERRIC CHLORIDE FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT FROM PVS TECHNOLOGIES, INC., AT \$578.00 PER DRY TON FOR 2020

WHEREAS: this Ordinance repeals and replaces Ordinance No. 95-19 passed by the Rocky River City Council on December 16, 2019 authorizing the Safety-Service Director to purchase Ferric Chloride for the WWTP from PVS Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$558.00 per dry ton as the dollar amount indicated was incorrect; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids having specifications with the potential to renew on an annual basis for the purchase of ferric chloride for 2020 at the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS: two (2) bids were received on November 8, 2019 for ferric chloride, and were reviewed by the Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service and Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent have determined that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the lowest and best bid for ferric chloride from PVS Technologies, Inc., 10900 Harper Avenue, Detroit, MI 48213.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 95-19 passed on December 16, 2019 authorizing the Safety-Service Director to purchase Ferric Chloride for the WWTP from PVS Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$558.00 per dry ton is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase Ferric Chloride for one (1) year (with a potential renewal) from PVS Technologies, Inc., 10900 Harper Avenue, Detroit, MI 48213 at \$578.00 per dry ton;

SECTION 3. That funds for the purchase of ferric chloride shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

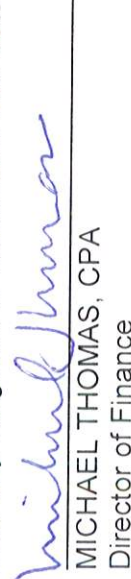

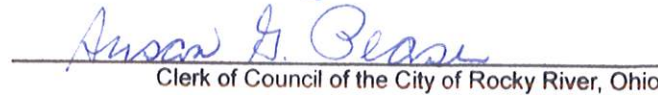
