ORDINANCE NO. 74-20

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SPECIALIZED CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE 2020 CRACK & JOINT SEALING PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000.00 INCLUDING CONTINGENCY COSTS

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2020 Crack & Joint Sealing Program which commences during this fall season; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received on September 4, 2020, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Service Director and City Engineer have evaluated the bids and recommend that the lowest and best bid from Specialized Construction, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Forty One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$41,650.00) as further described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Safety Service Director a contingency allowance of Eight Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$8,350.00) will be allocated for the sole purpose of paying for unforeseen construction costs not previously outlined in the bid specifications, in addition to the base contract of Forty One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$41,650.00) for a total cost of Fifty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$50,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Rocky River and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Specialized Construction, Inc., 711 Harvard Ave., Cuyahoga Hts., Ohio, 44105, in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$50,000.00) including contingency costs.

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2020 Crack and Joint Sealing Project along with any contingency costs, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund – Crack Sealing account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
