ORDINANCE NO. 9-20

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2020 WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT AND PAVEMENT RESURFACING FOR STORY ROAD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,096,000.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2020 Water Main Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing for Story Road; and,

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., be accepted which is not to exceed One Million Ninety-Six Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$1,096,000.00) as further explained in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., 20389 First Avenue, Middleburg Heights, OH 44130 for the 2020 Water Main Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing for Story Road in an amount not to exceed \$1,096,000.00.

SECTION 2. That \$1,096,000.00 shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund – Capital Improvements Roads account.

SECTION 3. That the City will be reimbursed by Cleveland Water Division through the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately because of imperative nature of the maintenance of the water utility and that by immediately commencing work will allow the City to fully use the construction season ahead and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

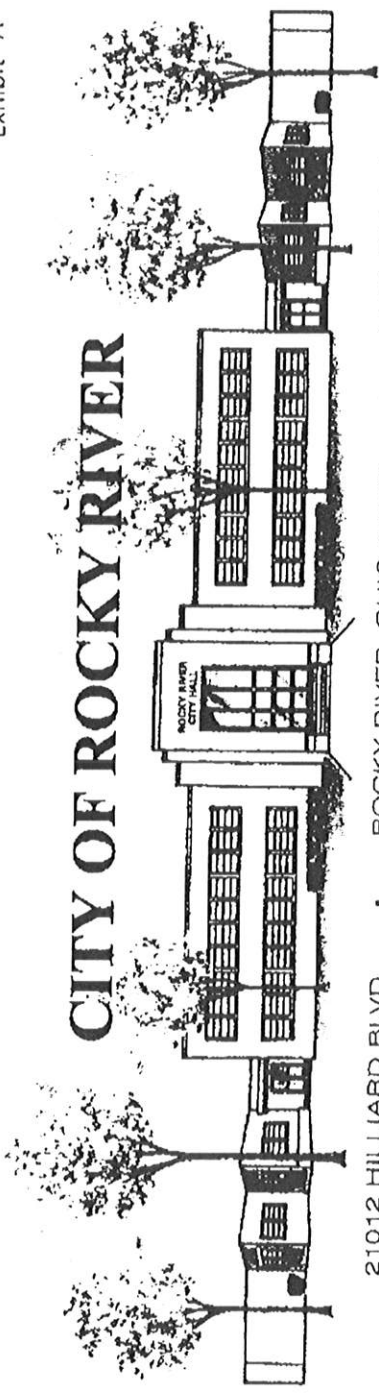

Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co., Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work to the City of Rocky River and has also completed water main replacement projects in the City of Lakewood, the City of Elyria, and Mayfield Village. Dan Uhlir, design engineer and construction manager from DLZ of Ohio, Inc. for the City of Lakewood's 2018 Water Main Replacement Project; John Schneider, Elyria City Engineer; and Thomas Cappello, Mayfield Village Engineer, all gave favorable recommendations for Fabrizio Trucking and Paving Co., Inc.

Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co., Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
